Pat Alderfer, our longtime Family-to-Family volunteer coordinator, won *2016 NAMI Texas Enduring Volunteer of the Year* award.



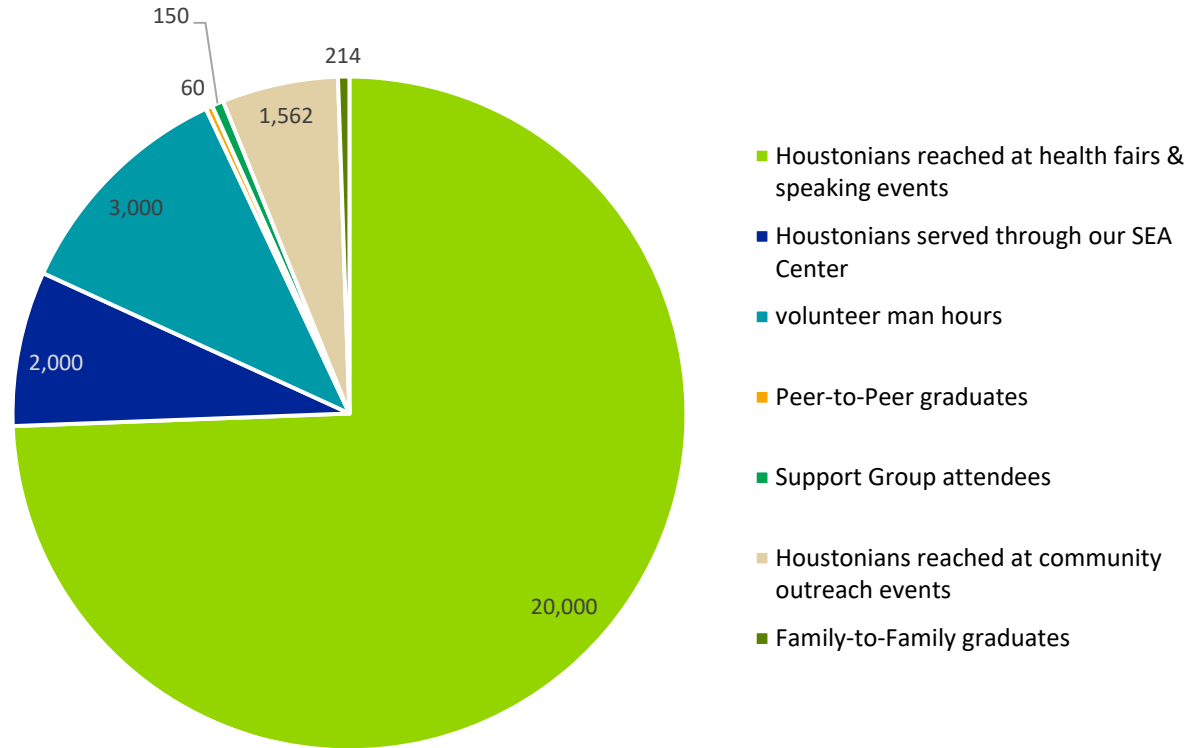
Emmitt Biffle won the *2016 NAMI Texas Consumer Quality of Life* award.

- Over 20,000 Houstonians reached in 33 health and employment fairs, and other community forums to learn about mental health wellness
- 2,000 Houstonians supported with mental health and social service information, resources *and* referrals through our peer-facilitated **NAMI Support, Education & Advocacy (SEA) Center** and **S.E.A. Center Mobile Resource Van**.
- 1,562 people reached in 72 **In Our Own Voice** community presentations on mental health and wellness given by those Houstonians living in recovery.
- 214 family members and caregivers attended 14 **NAMI Family to Family** and **NAMI Basics Classes**. They now have the tools to help their loved ones in the journey of recovery.
- 150 Houstonians, on average, attended our **NAMI Family Support Groups** and **NAMI Connection Recovery Support Groups** located throughout Harris and Montgomery Counties.
- 60 Houstonians living with a mental illness graduated from eight of our signature **NAMI Peer to Peer** Education classes
- Our use of over 3,000 hours of volunteer-driven programs provided NAMI Greater Houston with over \$65,000 of in-kind man hours
- \$325,000; total raised during our 2016 NAMI Walk; making the NAMI Greater Houston Walk the third largest NAMI fundraiser in the nation!
